SELF-IDENTITY...WHO AM I?

(ASIAN, FEMINIST, AND LGBTQ FOCUS) A eighty minute interactive "human interest" lecture exploring the search for "cultural identity" through the personal story of the presenter as an out, Asian American, woman growing up the rural south, overcoming obstacles such as racism, prejudice, stereotyping, homophobia, bi-phobia within the LBGT community, filial piety, and a severe disability (Tourette's Syndrome), allowing for a greater level of understanding about identity among participants. She will provide insights to both church ministers, leaders, and other participants on how to build a more inclusive community, especially when dealing with multi-cultural environments. 10-15 minute Q&A at the end of the lecture.
